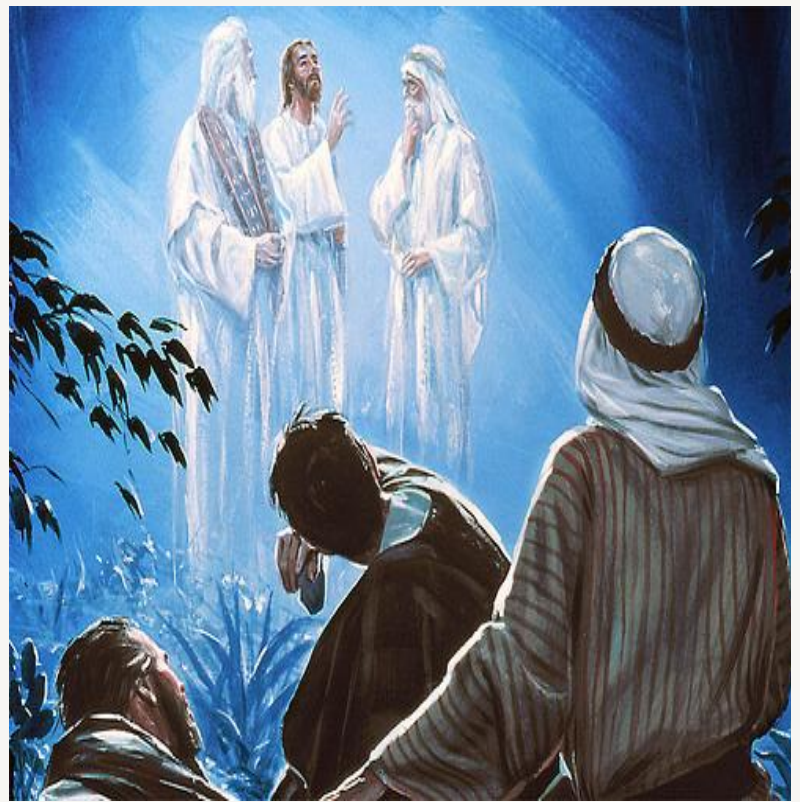

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. JOHN

Jesus was transformed before their very eyes! He displayed in all His glory the son of God, before the very eyes of the Apostles - Peter, James and his brother John.

Lent is a time we too look for inner transformation. A time to turn back to the Lord, a time to change our heart and mind. As we are told on Ash Wednesday, a time *to repent and believe in the Gospel*.

Repentance is more than regret or remorse. It is a deep sorrow for what we have done. A sorrow that might make us yearn to make changes, changes allowing us to more closely follow Jesus. In the power of the Eucharist, we gain the grace and strength to see our need for repentance.

Each of us have models of good behavior around us to imitate. People we see who follow the law of the Lord; people who are good, patient, kind, merciful, full of the love and peace of Christ. By noticing their behaviors and seeking to imitate them, we can conform to the Body of Christ, seeking transformation of our inner self through witness.

The first step towards repentance is to acknowledge we have done wrong. No human being is perfect and even on our brightest day, we might sin, in thought, word, or deed. Sometimes it is hard to admit we have wronged the Lord, even to the point it affects others, or our peace in Christ. If we do recognize it, the second step is to regret that transgression.

We feel sorrow for the wrong we do, in order to move towards repentance. True regret is when we feel bad for the pain, we have caused by doing wrong and causing problems. If we can feel that sorrow, we move forward by being committed to never repeat the act regardless of the temptations or situation. This is resolve; knowing it is within our power to change the way we act, or the things we do.

One of the most complex things to face in repentance is to repair the damage we've done. This is described by reconciliation, wherein we set things right. It may be as easy as an apology, going to confession, or adopting simple acts of kindness, a smile, a nod, or a one-on-one talk with God.

In the transfiguration of Christ, Jesus revealed His glory as the Son of God. Our Lenten journey is a transfiguration of sorts. Repentance is inner transformation. The simple practice of faith, namely in prayer, fasting, and giving to others, is a sure way to conversion. In the process, we move towards our eternal reward.
