

WHAT WE BELIEVE -

THE DOCTRINE OF THE REAL PRESENCE

The doctrine of the Real Presence asserts that in the Holy Eucharist, Jesus is present-body and blood, with His soul and divinity-under the appearance of bread and wine. This teaching is based in a variety of Scriptural passages including 1 Corinthians 10:16-17; 11:23-29 and especially, John 6:32-71, wherein Jesus delivers the famous "Bread of Life" discourse. The belief in the Real Presence has been solidly held by the Church since its beginning and the early Church Fathers interpreted the Scriptures literally.

Saint Theodore of Mopsuesta (c. A.D. 350-428) said, "When Christ gave the bread He did not say, 'This is the symbol of my body,' but, 'This *is* my body.' In the same way, when He gave the cup of His blood He did not say, 'This is the symbol of my blood,' but 'This *is* by blood'" [Catechetical Homilies 5:1 (c. A.D. 410].

The Catechism of the Catholic Church adds: "This presence is called 'real'- by which is not intended to exclude the other types of presence as if they could not be 'real' too, but because it is present in the fullest sense: that is to say it is a *substantial* presence by which Christ, God and man, makes Himself wholly and entirely present" (CCC#1374).

The Diocese of Evansville will launch a year-long "Eucharistic Revival" culminating in the National Eucharistic Conference in Indianapolis, July 17-21, 2024. The year will begin with the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, June 19, 2023. The feast of Corpus Christi was established by Pope Urban IV in 1264. In his bull (named after the leaden seal [the bulla] that was traditionally appended at the end of an order to authenticate it), *Transiturus de Hoc Mundo*, Pope Urban IV said: "Although this sacred sacrament is celebrated every day in the solemn rite of the Mass, we nevertheless believe it is useful and worthy that a more solemn feast be celebrated, at least once a year, especially to confuse and refute the hostility of the heretics." Meaning that Urban saw the feast of Corpus Christi as a way to evangelize the non-Catholics, through Eucharistic Processions in public, of our belief that the consecrated host is truly, really, and substantially the body and blood of Jesus Christ.
