

FROM FR. SURESH

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

This is the seventeenth Sunday of ordinary time, and this Sunday the Church draws our attention to the need of prayer in all circumstances of our life. She reminds us that prayer is the key to unlock and enter the heart of God. Today, Christ himself gives us this key to success.

He teaches us how to pray, as well as encourages us to pray without ceasing. In first reading of this week Abraham, our father in faith, interceded on behalf of Lot, his nephew. He stood in the gap for Lot's Family in Sodom and Gomorrah. Through this, he demonstrated that he was a great intercessor.

Abraham teaches us that we have a duty to intercede for others in prayer. In today's gospel too, Jesus teaches that we have a duty to prayer for those who sin against us. We must not under estimate the power of prayer of intercession. There is a saying that: "God governs the world, while prayer governs God." 
