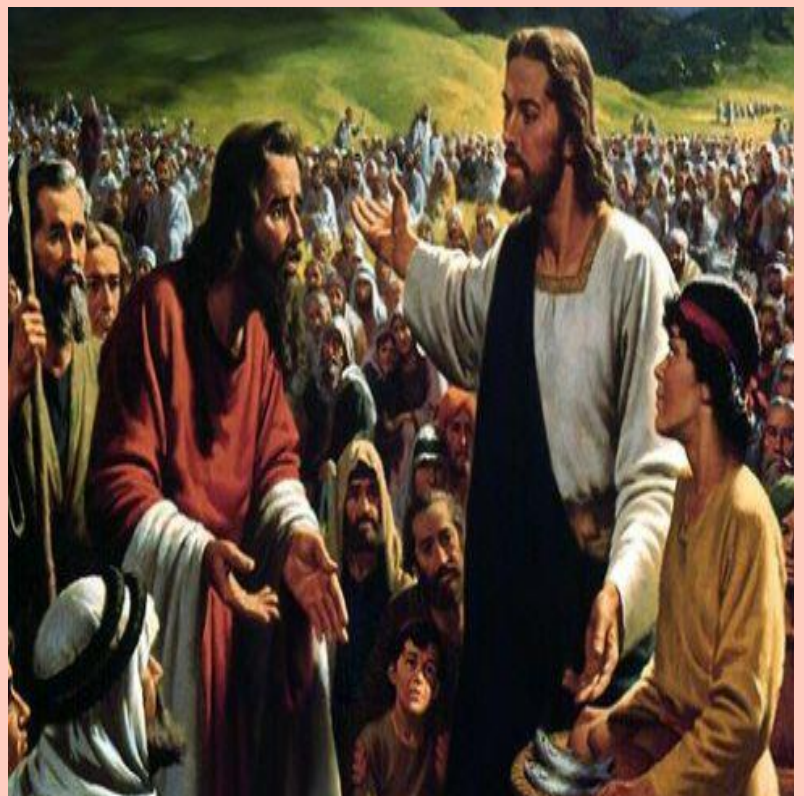

A REFLECTION

FROM FR. SURESH

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

This is the seventeenth Sunday of ordinary time, and this Sunday the Church draws our attention to the need of prayer in all circumstances of our life. She reminds us that prayer is the key to unlock and enter the heart of God. Today, Christ himself gives us this key to success.

He teaches us how to pray, as well as encourages us to pray without ceasing. In first reading of this week Abraham, our father in faith, interceded on behalf of Lot, his nephew. He stood in the gap for Lot's Family in Sodom and Gomorrah. Through this, he demonstrated that he was a great intercessor.

Abraham teaches us that we have a duty to intercede for others in prayer. In today's gospel too, Jesus teaches that we have a duty to prayer for those who sin against us. We must not under estimate the power of prayer of intercession. There is a saying that: "God governs the world, while prayer governs God." Through our intercession, God can save the righteous, heal the sick, and save those in all types of danger. It does not matter how far they are from us, because distance is not a barrier for God to hear us or act on our behalf.

The priest, as the pastor of his sheep, has the greatest duty to pray for his people. Considering this role of pastor, I would like to visit and give Holy Communion to those who are sick and home bound on every Friday. Please let me know if you're sick or homebound and want to receive holy communion? I would also request all those parishioners of St. Mary's and St. Joan of Arc to inform the parish office if you come to know any one is sick or home bound?
