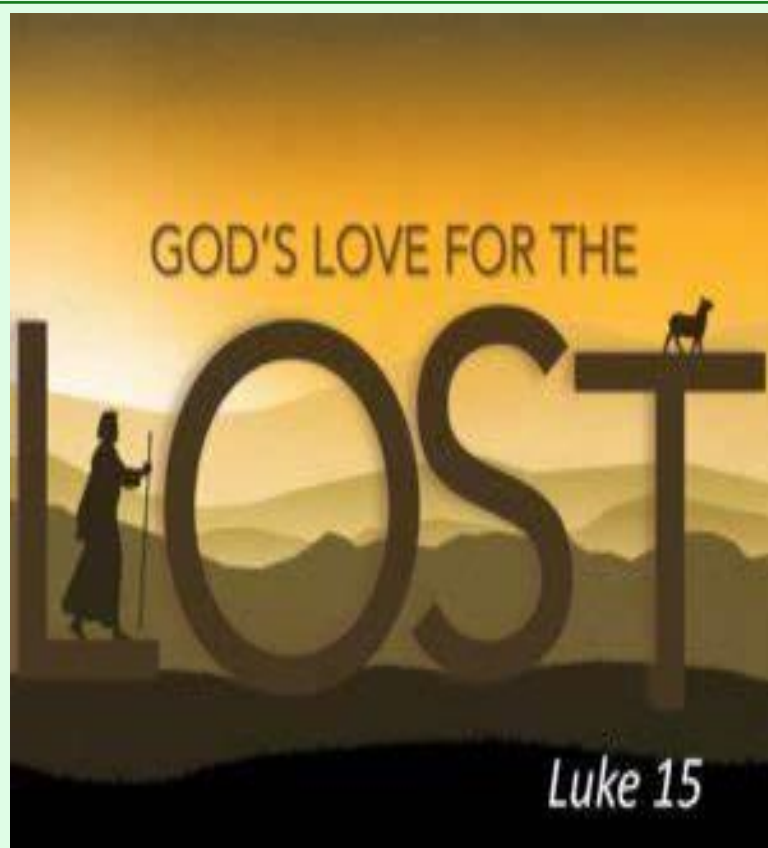

# A REFLECTION

FROM FR. SURESH

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Jesus Christ.

This Sunday Jesus speaks to us about the parable of the one lost sheep among 100 Sheep. In those days, 100 sheep would have seemed like a very large flock for the ordinary people Jesus spoke this parable to. So, it would have been the combined flock of several families, and each family would have provided shepherds to watch it. So, when one of the sheep went missing, they would have told the youngest, least senior shepherd that he had to go find the stray.

For some of the people listening to Jesus, this would be a familiar situation. They can remember when they were the least important shepherds who were sent after wanderers. They can imagine walking through the scratchy brush and scraping their legs as they climbed the rocky hills, all while the other shepherds just sat watching other sheep.

Then when they found that sheep, they had to lift it up, put it on their shoulders, and carry it back. They were already tired from having to look for it. They might have been very frustrated and angry with that wayward sheep.

But the parable has a surprise ending. The shepherd is overjoyed at finding the lost sheep. Despite all the work and effort he has put into finding it, he is happy for this lost lamb. He is so happy he calls the local people and throws a celebration for the sheep!

This is how Jesus sees us. Despite all the suffering and work, he is overjoyed when we are restored to him. So dear friends try to not miss Mass on Sunday because Jesus waits to meet everyone on every Sunday. It doesn't matter for him who we are or what we are, but what matters for him is whether we are ready to meet him or not?

I humbly request all of you to make use of every opportunity that our parishes offer you to meet Jesus, starting from Catechism to Holy Eucharist?
