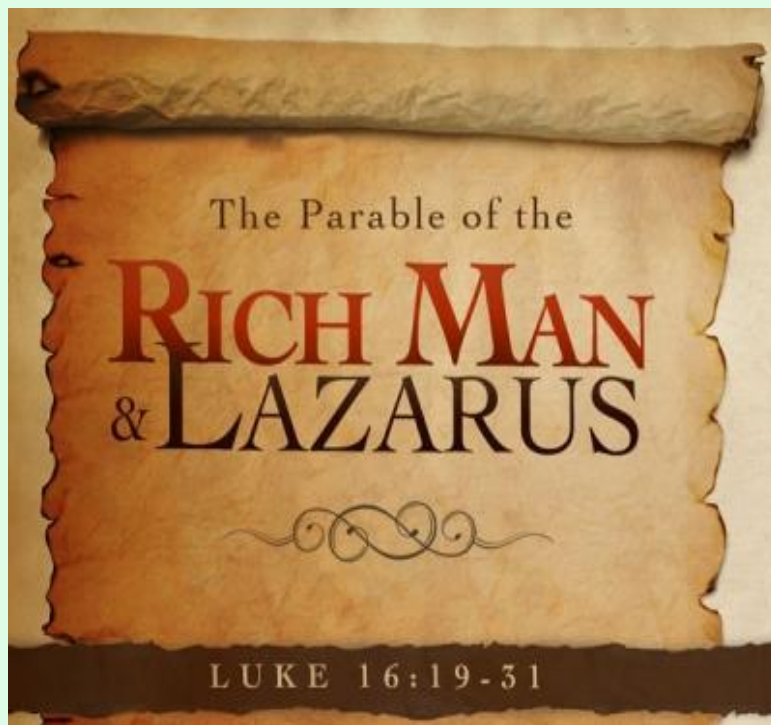

FROM FR. SURESH

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

The readings for the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time call us to care about others. In the first reading we are warned against being complacent while others suffer. The psalm praises the justice of God. In the second reading Paul reminds us to pursue virtues. In the gospel Jesus tells the parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus, where a wealthy man ignored the needs of a poor man every day.

This week's parable of Jesus about the "Rich Man and Lazarus" is not about the rich and poor in its strict sense. It's all about help and need. The rich man was so focused on his own comfort that he did nothing to help the starving Lazarus whom he saw every day. He should have known better. The law given in the Old Testament made it clear that caring for those in distress needs to be a priority. Jesus calls us to leave our comfort zones to help those who are in need. And healing those who are in need should be our priority. When our own comfort is our priority, then we are really just serving ourselves. Jesus calls us to join him in this mission of mercy because he wants us to know the true joy which comes from helping those who are in need.
