# A REFLECTION

FROM FR. SURESH

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

A little boy wanted \$100 very much, and his mother told him to pray to God with Faith. He prayed and prayed for two weeks, but nothing turned up. Then he decided perhaps he should write God a letter requesting the \$100. When the postal authorities received the letter addressed to God, they opened it up and decided to send it to the President. The President was so impressed and touched that he instructed his secretary to send the little boy a check for \$5. He thought that this would appear to be a lot of money to a little boy. The little boy was delighted with the \$5 and sat down to write a thank-you letter to God, which ran as follows: *"Dear God: Thank you very much for the money. I noticed that you had to send it through Washington. Dad said that, as usual, they deducted \$95 for themselves in the name of 'Homeland Security' to save our country from terrorists."*

In this week's gospel Jesus speaks about planting a tree in the sea. Using words alone sounds impossible and ridiculous to us.
